

- **College Ready**
 - **5.8 million** college students are currently enrolled in an online course.*

- K-12 Response 73% of K-12 schools nationwide have implemented online course options for students.***

- O Purpose driven, not profit driven







Launch Course Development Process



2017-2018 Springfield Public Schools Seats to Date




Launch Government EOC Scores
