
# Last Call (?!)

- Total LEA allocations (90% of state): \$1,759,464,658
- LEAs with >= \$1,000 remaining: 398
- LEA amount remaining: \$514,239,192

Leave complete notes, and


Ensure others have knowledge.

- Amount
- Purpose
- Justification



## **Gentle Reminders**

### 20% Set Aside to Address Learning Loss



- 20 percent minimum
- Evidence-based interventions
- Process:
  - Identify need
  - Identify interventions that are evidence-based
  - Select intervention and document evidence
- Revise plan if necessary

### Parent Reimbursement Grant




- With the liquidation extension:
  - LEAs may claim reimbursement
    - To parents for allowable expenses, and
    - To the LEA for allowable expenses, if
    - The expenses were obligated by 9/30/23.
    - Parent Reimbursement Grant Guidance

### **ARP-HCY**



- Total Allocation ~ \$12.8 million
- Total Expenses ~ \$2.48 million
- Obligate by 9/30/24
- DESE will survey LEAs to prepare for liquidation extension request.
