Certified school counselors are trained to facilitate a comprehensive, K-12 PROGRAM that is based on the needs of the whole child...academic, social/emotional, and career. Most schools in Missouri use the Missouri Comprehensive School Counseling Program (MCSCP).

The program is designed for ALL students.

Fully implemented programs allow school counselors to do what they've been trained to do, and research has shown that schools having fully implemented programs enjoy better school climate, better test results, better attendance and better graduation rates.

DEFINITION OF MISSOURI COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL COUNSELING PROGRAM (MCSCP)

A proactive and preventative school program that addresses social/emotional, academic, and career development of all students by providing K-12 Curriculum, K-12 Responsive Services, K-12 Individual (Educational) Planning, and a K-12 System Support (Management & PD). It is directly aligned with the National Model of the American School Counselor Association (ASCA).

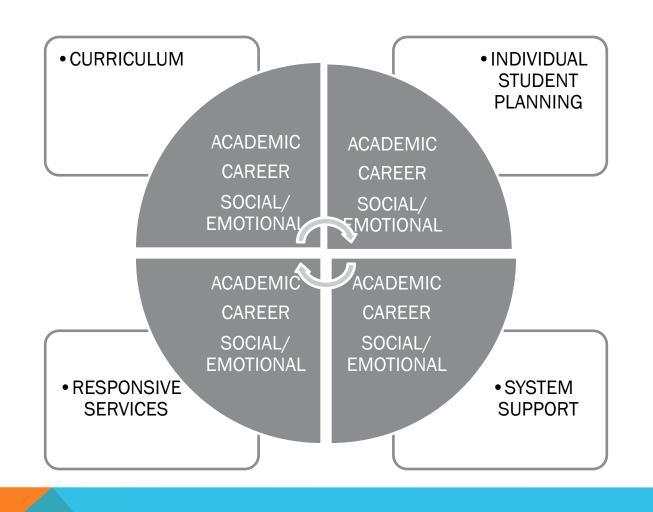

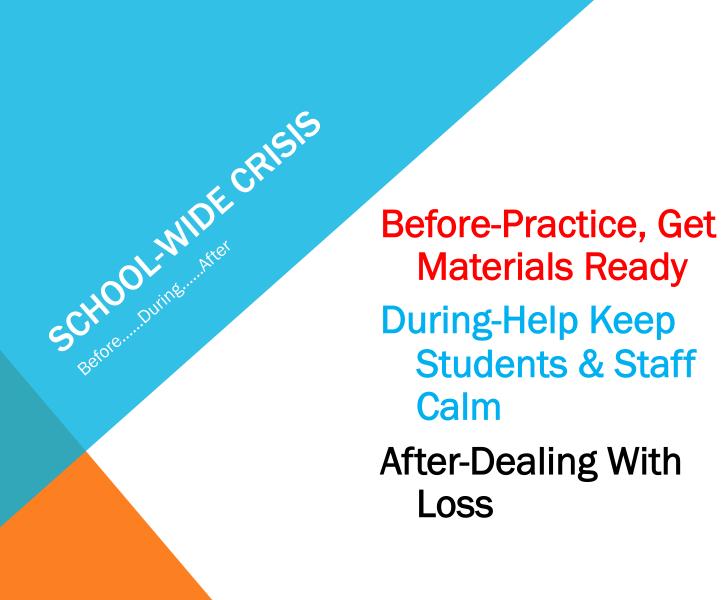

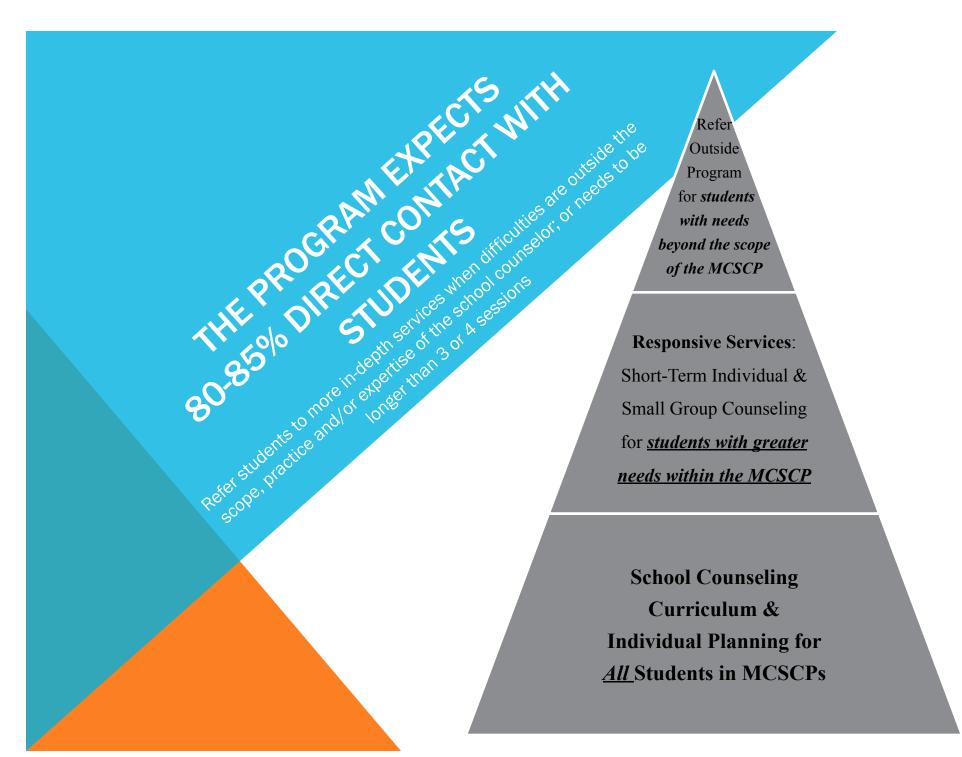
RESPONSIVE SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Referrals to outside agencies
- Working on a trauma-informed team
- RTI team member
- Consultation with other professionals
- 504/IEP team member (not the coordinator)

GROUP COUNSELING WORKING WITH 2 OR MORE STUDENTS WITH THE SAME CONCERN AT THE SAME TIME

- Based upon building/student need, as well as time
- Short-term (not more than 6-8 weeks)
- Within the school counselor's scope of practice & expertise
- Using Theoretical and Research-based Problem-solving Group Techniques (Using group dynamics to help address the issue or concern-this includes identifying appropriate members of the group, organizing the group activities, and evaluating progress.)

BARRIERS TO IMPLEMENTATION OF MCSCP AND THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE SCHOOL COUNSELOR

- Lack of understanding & support by/about the program by stakeholders
- Being assigned non-school counseling duties
- Covering for absent teachers
- Disciplinarians
- Facilitating the school-wide testing program
- Lack of resources

- Resistance of the shift from services for a few to services for all
- Being written into IEPs 504 Coordinator
- Irregular communication with the administrator
- Inappropriate Evaluation Instrument (i.e. Teacher Evaluation Instrument)

RESEARCH HAS SHOWN:

Found in schools (high schools) with more fully implemented CSCP:

- higher 11th grade MAP Communication Arts test scores
- higher graduation rates
- better attendance (also found this in middle schools)
- fewer discipline problems (also found this in middle schools)

- Enhances ALL students' academic performance; career and social /emotional development
- Provides a clearly defined organizational structure for the CSCP
- Establishes a clearly defined job description for school counselors
- Provides a way to supervise and evaluate the program and school counselors
- Inspires administrative leadership for CSCP implementation and evaluation
- Meets Missouri School Improvement Program standards for CSCP
- Provides a means of accountability through use of data
